The Boys and Girls Varsity Soccer and Girls Softball programs advanced to the state regional final game, and the Varsity Football program advanced to the state regional semifinal game. Our Track and Field program had three regional champions and six state qualifiers. We saw our Boys Lacrosse program amass to 24 participants and it is steadily growing.
